

Discovered by Christopher Columbus, it is famous as “the island of sugar” where is still made a strong rum.

But the main attractions are the numerous geological curiosities, like a large natural bridge (**Gu**
ele Grand Gouffre
) in the north side or the enormous cavern called
Grotte du Trou à Diable
in the middle east side.

To testimony the ancient activities, there are ruins of old mills and ancient distilleries.

The white and unpolluted beaches are protected by the coral reef.
